

WOJFC Inclimate Weather Policy:

The purpose of these guidelines is to provide a default policy to those responsible for making decisions concerning the suspension and restarting of contests based on the presence of lightning. The preferred sources from which to request such a policy for your facility would include your state high school association and the nearest office of the National Weather Service.

Proactive Planning:

- 1. Assign staff to monitor local weather conditions before and during events.**
- 2. Develop criteria for suspension and resumption of play:**
 - a. A 30-second or less flash-to-bang count calls for removal of the athletes from the field to an appropriate shelter.**
 - b. Thirty-minute rule. Once play has been suspended, wait at least 30 minutes after the last flash of lightning is witnessed or thunder is heard prior to resuming play.**
- 3. Develop an evacuation plan, including identification of appropriate nearby shelters.**
- 4. Hold periodic reviews for appropriate personnel.**
